## Food Service

Visit the Pymatuning Valley Schools website at [www.pvschools.org](http://www.pvschools.org) for free & reduced applications, monthly menus, announcements and the link to the My School Bucks website for access to meal account balances. Accessing the My School Bucks website is free of charge and allows you to view your child's purchases, account balances and to set-up text/email alerts for account balances. Payments can also be made on the website for a processing fee.



All students will receive a free & reduced meal application the first day of school. Please return them as soon as possible. Only one application is needed per household. There is a short tutorial on how to fill out a meal application located on the school website, under the "Food Service" tab. If you have already received a letter stating that you are pre-approved for free meals, you will not need to complete the meal application. Furthermore, any charges incurred before your application is approved are the parent's responsibility. Applications are available at the school front office, the administration office and school district's website.

## Transportation

**Ohio Transportation Rule:** "Pupils must leave or board the bus at locations to which they have been assigned" This rule will continue where students will be picked up/dropped off at ONE (1) location designated by parents. It is imperative the district safeguard all students with one designated pickup and drop off location. As specified in the Operations and Rules, designated locations will be adopted by the BOE as the only location(s) a student may be picked up or dropped off. Phone calls to the school during the school day can no longer be accepted. If a change is needed, the district requests that parents make arrangements for someone to pick the child(ren) up at the student's designated stop.

### REVENUES:

In Ohio, the funding of public schools is a shared state and local partnership. The level of state support is largely dependent upon the value of the local property tax base. The majority of funding for the operation of the district is accounted for in the General Fund. Tax dollars collected are also accounted for in the Local School's General Fund revenue total of \$14,339,340.

### EXPENSES:

The General Fund is used to account for all ordinary operations of the school district. The majority of all tax dollars collected for the district is accounted in this area. General Fund expenditures for the 2018-2019 school year were \$14,233,809.
